Solid Wood

Solid wood is a term used to distinguish between engineered wood and regular lumber. Supreme in their beauty, warmth, and longevity, solid wood floors make an elegant, timeless addition to your home.

Characteristics of Solid Wood

There are both advantages and disadvantages to solid wood. Perhaps the greatest advantage of solid wood is in its appearance. Most people consider solid wood more attractive than engineered wood like fiberboard. It is also more attractive than oriented strand board, and the appearance of fiberboard is sometimes enhanced with a solid wood veneer.

The main disadvantage of solid wood is cost, as it's usually more expensive than engineered wood. Engineered wood can be made cheaply from waste material like sawdust and chips, but solid wood must be made from species with especially hard wood. This requires large sections of wood that are mostly free from defects; finding such wood is often more difficult and time consuming for the manufacturer, thus adding to the higher cost.

Solid Wood Floors

Solid wood floors make lovely additions to a home, but there are several things to take into consideration before buying and installing such a floor.

Sensitivity to moisture (causes solid wood to expand and can lead to squeaking and buckling) combined with a high cost of installation (solid wood has to be nailed to the sub-floor, ruling out their use on concrete) rules out solid wood floors for basements and similar areas.
